The Nold Open device is a wireless electronic accessory to be used with smartphones to control electronic doors, gates, and barriers.

Please read this User Guide carefully before installing and using the product.





OVERVIEW

Power off your existing automatic gate opener system either using the master switch or at the circuit breaker box. Review all the instructions before you start to avoid any surprises during installation.

HARDWARE INFO

Nold Open features dual output that can be used either controlling two separate electronic gates/garage doors or controlling two functions of one electronic gate/garage door. These outputs are connected to the control input of the central electronics of the door / gate mover equipment(s).

There are two inputs on the device associated with each output. These can be used to sense the state of the corresponding gate/door.


Low-voltage power supply is provided for the device from an external source, preferably from the power supply output installed for this purpose on the connected control panel. In the absence thereof, an external power supply unit must be provided for operating the device, whose output voltage is within the operational voltage range indicated in the technical specifications. The Nold Open power supply input is polarity-independent.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

The installation section of the guide has been produced for trained personnel, so it is advised to have the installation work performed by a specialist recommended by the manufacturer and the distributor, or by the specialist who puts into operation your electronic door, gate or barrier.

Installation works must be completed and electric connections must be established by appropriate working methods and due diligence.

The manufacturer and distributor of Nold Open are not liable for any damage arising from incorrect, improper or unprofessional installation (putting into operation).




OUT1	First output of the device. Should be connected to the appropriate input of the main unit of the gate system (type: dry contact)
OUT2	Second output of the device. Should be connected to the appropriate input of the main unit of the gate system (type: dry contact)
IN1	First input of the device for detecting closed position of the controlled gate in association with OUT1 (type: dry contact) The usage of the input is optional, can be enabled/disabled in the application.
IN2	Second input of the device for detecting closed position of the controlled gate in association with OUT2 (type: dry contact) The usage of the input is optional, can be enabled/disabled in the application.
NC	Not connected. Reserved for future use.
PWR	Power supply input of the device (polarity independent, for more information please see the electrical specification of the device at the end of this document)


WIRE IT UP

Before installing Nold Open, please study the user guide of your main access control unit, with particular regard to the chapter on accessory connections, and compare it with this User Guide and the connection drawing therein.

■■■ *The usage of the input is optional, can be enabled/disabled in the application.


1. Put the wires of the gate opener into their places (connector)

The outputs of the device are dry contact relay outputs. The inputs can only be driven by dry contact outputs.

Each output and input reserves 2 pins in the connector of the device. Regarding the pinout of device please check the wiring diagram on pages 10-11.

The operation mode of the relay outputs can be configured in the application. Momentary pulse mode with adjustable pulse length or static on/off mode can be chosen.

NOTE: Most of the garage door/gate openers are compatible with the pulse mode only therefore it might be harmful for these devices to be used with on/off mode. Avoid switching to static on/off mode unless you know what you are doing.




2. Plug the connector into the Nold Open device

The Nold Open must be connected to the appropriate points according to the connection drawing, with the control panel de-energized.

3. Fasten the wires with a screwdriver

4. Mount Nold Open on the wall with 2 screws.

The device should be installed as close as possible to the entry zone and as far as possible from metallic elements as they negatively affect the transmission distance of Bluetooth® signals. The device can be used both indoors and outdoors. In case of outdoor use, the device must be fitted below a weatherproof protective cover. The device should be installed at a height of at least 1.5 metres above ground level.

GET THE APPLICATION

To be able to operate your Nold Open device, download the Nold app to your smartphone from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store. The app will guide you through creating your account, connecting and setting up your device.

The Nold Open power supply input is polarity-independent.








The device is connected to a smartphone



The device received command from a smartphone








BLUETOOTH ON

Turn on Bluetooth on your phone. Start the App and follow the instructions.

The two control outputs of Nold Open with all of its associated functionalities are mapped into virtual keys in the application. So the device can be controlled through these virtual keys. Virtual keys can be shared with other users.



iBeacon compatibility

Nold Open supports the Apple® iBeacon™ standard. When approaching the Nold Open device, notification of the application on the iOS™ operating system automatically appears on the display of your phone. To enable this function, go to Settings and choose automatic notifications of virtual keys.



Operational radius

Depending on the location and line of sight of the device, the operational distance of the integrated Bluetooth® radio can vary between 5 and 50 metres.
